Perseverance to Move Forward




For 15 months the staff of AgeSmart persevered and continued to provide services to older adults as we worked from home. On June 16, 2021 we were elated to welcome people back to the office and were so happy to be here ourselves. Thanks to the more than 80%

of Illinois residents over the age of 65 who were vaccinated we felt safe once again to provide in-person assistance.

- Over 4,000 calls were made to help people access vaccines
- The first ever Virtual Aging Expo was held in May
- AgeSmart's staff helped 3,254 people save \$2,756,383 on their benefits (average of \$847 per person)
- Over 585,000 Meals on Wheels were delivered to homebound older adults
- 18,600 reassurance calls were made to older adults
